RE: Monthly Fire Department Report for August, 2014
DATE: September 1, 2014

Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 73 calls during the month of August. The breakdown is as follows:

- **Eight Fire Calls:**
 - four in the Village – CO detector activation at 7 Chestnut Street; fire alarm activation at 23 Elm Street, Village and Town Hall; fire alarm activation at 2 South Portage Street, Welch Office Building (burnt popcorn); and oxygen system problem at 26 Cass Street, Absolut Care;
 - two in the Town – brush fires on McKinley Road, Pinehurst Golf Course;
 - one on the NYS Thruway – semi-trailer on fire at mile marker 490; and
 - one Mutual Aid to Ripley for a structure fire.
- **Three MVA's:**
 - two in the Village – two-vehicle accident at East Main and Cass Streets; and a bicycle versus car at 96 East Main Street;
 - one on the NYS Thruway – two vehicles at mile marker 480.2 eastbound.
- **58 EMS Calls:** 23 in the Village; seven in the Town; one on the NYS Thruway; 26 at Absolut Care; and one Mutual Aid to Mayville for a gorge rescue.
- **Four Service Calls:** wires burning in trees at Route 394 and Martin Wright Road; wires arcing at substation, Route 394 and Old Hawley Street; ambulance transport from Westfield Memorial Hospital to a residence; and wires down in tree at 7609 Route 20.
