RE: Monthly Fire Department Report for January, 2015
DATE: February 1, 2015

Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 52 calls during the month of January. The breakdown is as follows:

- **Six Fire Calls:**
 - five in the Village – two general alarms at 26 Cass Street, Absolut Care; a fire alarm activation at 23 Elm Street, Village and Town offices; a fire alarm activation for burnt popcorn at 215 East Main Street, Westfield Central School; and a structure fire at 5 Bank Street; and
 - one in the Town – smoke alarm at 7550 Hardscrabble Road.
- **Three MVA's:**
 - one in the town – 6799 Route 394; and
 - two on the NYS Thruway – one at mile marker 483.3 westbound; and car hit A-291 at mile marker 481.5 westbound.
- **40 EMS Calls:** 24 in the Village; three in the Town; 12 at Absolut Care; and one Mutual Aid to Brocton.
- **Three Service Calls:** two pole fires, one on Route 20 and one at Holt and Jefferson Streets; and wires sparking at Clinton and Franklin Streets.
