RE: Monthly Fire Department Report for July, 2016
DATE: August 1, 2016

Members of the Fire Department of Westfield responded to a total of 57 calls during the month of July. The breakdown is as follows:

- **Five Fire Calls:**
 - four in the Village – grass fire at 8 First Street; natural gas leak at 26 Cass Street, Absolut Care (evacuation of 103 patients); fire alarm activation at 26 Cass Street, Absolut Care; and brush fire at the Village barns on Bourne Street; and
 - one in the Town – interior fire alarm activation at 7853 Route 5.
- **Four MVA's:**
 - two in the Town – car into guardrail at 7688 Route 5; and a two-car accident at Route 394 and the NYS Thruway entrance;
 - one on the NYS Thruway – car vs. tractor-trailer at mile marker 783.2 westbound; and
 - one mutual aid to Ripley – three-vehicle accident at Route 20 and Forsythe Road.
- **45 EMS Calls:** 15 in the Village; 17 in the Town; three on the NYS Thruway; nine at Absolut Care; and one mutual aid for Mayville (standby for Fourth of July).
- **Two Service Calls:** natural gas leak at 30 East Main Street, FairPoint Communications; and odor of natural gas at 89 Bliss Street.
- **One False Alarm:** Better Baked Foods.
